Ambassador Grete Sillasen has dedicated her career to international relations, starting out with three postings for the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees.

She has been with the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs since 1994 and has held various senior positions in Copenhagen and abroad.

Prior to her appointment as ambassador to the Republic of Lithuania, she was the ambassador to the Philippines with cross accreditation to Palau, and the ambassador to Argentina with cross accreditation to Paraguay and Uruguay.

Ms. Sillasen holds a Master's degree in Law (LL.M) from the University of Aarhus, Denmark.

Her language proficiency includes English, Spanish, German and French in addition to her Danish mother tongue.

She is married to Mr. Kim Christensen, currently the Danish ambassador to Mexico, and together they have three children.
